Our Commitment

Analog Devices (ADI) seeks to protect biodiversity, ecosystems, and communities in our Manufacturing endeavors. Our approach is guided by globally accepted frameworks and applicable Regulations such as (EU) 2023/1115, the UN Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), and the Kunming–Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF). This statement forms the foundation of our position using the principles of land stewardship and sustainable development. ADI encourages our suppliers and partners to follow similar guidelines.

Greenfield Development

Analog Devices (ADI) seeks to protect biodiversity, ecosystems, and communities in our Manufacturing For any greenfield purchase or new site development, ADI will conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) or, where appropriate, an Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA). These assessments ensure business decisions are based on science and our commitment to human health and sustainability.

ADI seeks to preserve natural assets and protect ecosystems.

Protection of communities & Ecosystems

ADI does not endorse or participate in activities that relocate Indigenous populations, destroy forests, or convert natural habitats. We follow the mitigation hierarchy: first avoid impacts wherever possible. If they cannot be avoided, minimize them. If impacts still occur, support restoration of the affected environment.

Before any expansion, paving, rerouting of waterways, or infrastructure change on existing sites, ADI will evaluate potential environmental and social impacts first.

Broader Guidelines

- Avoid development near ecologically sensitive areas.
- Restore habitats that may be impacted by operations.
- Prefer recycled or reclaimed materials whenever feasible.
- Support tree planting and soil conservation only in at-risk areas.

By evaluating potential impacts and aligning with recognized global frameworks, ADI supports responsible land use and long-term sustainability across its global footprint.
