Re: Application Note - California Proposition 65

Analog Devices has a responsibility to provide appropriate warnings for Analog Devices products that expose a consumer, worker, or the environment to chemicals above California Proposition 65 (Prop 65) exposure limits.

For a small number of Analog Devices products, there could potentially be exposure to a Prop 65 substance (such as Ni or Pb on leads). This exposure would primarily be limited to occupational exposure by workers assembling Analog Devices components into an electronic assembly or product.

It is ultimately the responsibility of the manufacturer of each product using Analog Devices components to determine if there is a potential exposure to the end user of their product, but in general, Analog Devices components are not normally expected to be directly contacted or accessible by the end user, and little (if any) exposure would be anticipated.

The substances restricted under Prop 65 and their limits will continue to evolve and Analog Devices will need to maintain the proper warnings regularly.
