Re: Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) PBT Position Statement

To Whom It May Concern:

On January 6, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued final rules under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) to reduce exposures to five chemicals (identified in the table below) that are persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT).

Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))	68937-41-7
2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)	732-26-3
Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd)	87-68-3
Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)	133-49-3
